	Spread of virus From asymptomatic cases	<p>Preventative measures:</p> <p>Enhanced hygiene measures are to continue</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handwashing on arrival and at the end of each session • Hand sanitiser available in all rooms • Tables cleaned at the end of each session • Catch-it, kill-it, bin-it regime • Masks may be worn by adults in crowded areas if they wish <p>Ventilation of rooms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All rooms will be well ventilated whilst balancing the need to keep warm <p>Testing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adults will continue to use LFT (Lateral Flow Tests) twice a week <p>Adults and children with symptoms</p> <p>Please see government guidance for when to isolate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must self-isolate and take a PCR test • If positive they must isolate for 10 days • If negative they can return to normal duties

	Track and trace	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To be identified via Track and Trace NHS (not the school) • Children under the age of 18 do not need to isolate if they are identified as a <i>close contact</i> • Adults contacts – this is yet to be confirmed •
	Remote Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As before, if a child is self-isolating and not ill then on line learning will be provided for their time at home • Reception, Yrs 1&2 will use Tapestry • Yrs 3-6 will use Teams • Adjustments will be made for pupils with SEND
Outbreak Management Plan		<p>In the case of an outbreak as determined by Public Health England Loxwood School will revert to the risk assessment used for the Summer Term 2021. This will include reintroduction of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bubbles • Use of PPE including facemasks for parents and staff • A lockdown of parents and visitors entering the building • Restrictions of staff in staffrooms • Adults maintaining social distance were possible • Use of masks by parents and staff
