Rainbow Words	Silly Sentences	Spelling Story
Write your spelling words using a different colour for each letter.	Use your spelling words in a funny or silly sentence.	Write a short story using some of your spelling words.
Alphabetical Order	Secret Code	Vowel Colouring
Write your spelling words in alphabetical order.	Create your own secret code and write your spelling words out using the secret code. <div>Example: playing ↑ □ ← ⊕ ↓ ○ =</div>	Write your spelling words out using a different colour for the vowels. <div>Example: cheese football</div>
Wordsearch	Bubble Letters	Writing Race
Create your own wordsearch using your spelling words.	Write your spelling words in bubble writing, then colour the words in.	Write down as many of your spelling words in 1 minute.
Crosswords	Pyramid Words	Backward Spelling
Write your spelling words out into a crossword. <div>Example: t h i s n a i l k</div>	Write your spelling words out in a pyramid shape. <div>Example: snail = s s n s n a s n a i s n a i l</div>	Write your spelling words backwards. <div>Example: watching - gnihtaw</div>
Train Words	Word Scrambles	Missing Vowels
Write your spelling words as one long word. Use a different colour for each word. <div>Example: peoplechildrenwatchwait</div>	Write your spelling words with the letters mixed up. <div>Example: catch    hccat</div>	Write your spelling words without the vowels. <div>Example: ch-ldr-n = children</div>
