



## Year 2 Home Learning Projects

### Summer Term - Make a Splash!



Our topic for the summer term involves all things water related. Please complete 2 of these projects each half term so that by the Summer Holidays you will have completed at least 4 of the activities below. These activities are designed to get your creative juices flowing and to be a great opportunity to develop your learning with support from someone at home. I am really looking forward to sharing what you have learned and the new skills you have developed. Upload to Tapestry so that we can share your learning in the classroom.

<p><u><b>Green Fingers</b></u></p> <p><b>In Summer 2 we will be finding out all about plants in Science. Have a go at planting some seeds and see what you can grow!</b></p> <p>We'd love to see a picture of you and your plant! Perhaps you could record what happens to your plant in a diary format, using pictures, photos or sentences? Perhaps the sunflower that you planted at school is growing well - let me know how it is doing.</p>	<p><u><b>Summer Safari</b></u></p> <p><b>Go for a Summer stroll and see what living things you can find.</b></p> <p>Look out for common wild and garden plants (including trees) and insects, such as bees and butterflies. Keep a record of what you spot. You could make a tally chart, a pictogram or a bar chart to practice your data handling skills too!! <b>Maybe you can spot part of an animals life cycle, such as tadpoles, caterpillars, birds nesting!</b></p>	<p><u><b>Time's Up!</b></u></p> <p><b>Brush up on your telling the time skills.</b></p> <p>Can you help your family to tell the time? Have a go at making your own clock and using it to help you to learn to tell the time. Or maybe you might like to draw a timetable of a typical day at your house with times for the things that you usually do, like getting up or going to bed.</p>
<p><u><b>Build up a Musical Storm</b></u></p> <p><b>Get your creative juices flowing by composing and performing your own piece of music!</b> You can use anything you like to make a sound... can you start quietly and get louder and louder like waves crashing, then become quiet again, just like a storm? Or maybe you will be the conductor and your family will be the orchestra? Take a video of yourself performing for the class and share it on Tapestry!</p>	<p><u><b>A Splash of Colour!</b></u></p> <p><b>We are going to be learning some painting techniques used by famous painters such as Monet, Turner and Hockney. But who is your favourite artist?</b></p> <p>Tell me about your favourite painting and why you like it. Maybe you could have a go at painting in a similar style or go for a beach walk and sketch some of the things that you find? Perhaps you might set up your own gallery at home? I'd love to see what masterpieces you create!</p>	<p><u><b>Oh we do like to be beside the seaside!</b></u></p> <p><b>In Summer 2 we are going to be learning about seaside holidays in the past.</b></p> <p>Interview your families and older relatives about what their seaside holidays were like when they were children. Where did they go? What did they do? How was it different to holidays today?
