PE

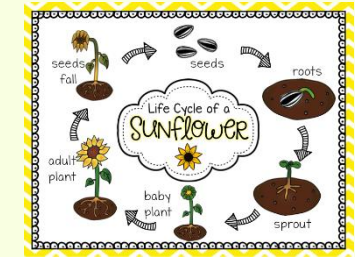
This term we will be doing:

English

Reading

This term, we will be exploring a range of texts, including twisted tradition tales and non-fiction books about bees to inspire our ideas and develop our comprehension skills.

Key Texts:

Jack and the Baked Beanstalk by Colin Stimpson, **The Villain's Version** by Kaye Umansky, **The Bee Book** by Charlotte Milner, **The Most Important Animal of All** by Penny Worms.

Writing

We will explore these key texts to develop our understanding of structure, vocabulary and grammar, using these as inspiration to plan, write and edit a variety of pieces including poetry, biographies, persuasive adverts and non-chronological reports.

Geography

Bee Conservation

We will learn why bees are important, the dangers they face and how to help protect them through observation and improving their environment.

History

Changes In The Monarchy

We will explore how power in Britain has changed over time, from absolute monarchy to today's constitutional monarchy, meeting key figures along the way.

Computing

Publishing

We will develop drawing and presentation skills, learning to create and organise images and text using a desktop publishing tool to design effective layouts.

RE

Buddhism

We will be exploring the Buddhism faith, focusing on its core beliefs, the main teachings and the significance of its holy places as places of worship. We will also learn about key Buddhist festivals and their importance within the religion.

Maths

Mass and Capacity

We will develop our knowledge of measurements looking at mass (kg/g) and volume and capacity (l/ml).

Fractions

We will focus on adding and subtracting fractions and finding fractions of an amount.

Money

We will focus on counting money, finding change and converting between pounds and pence.

Time

We will learn to tell the time, developing our understanding of hours, minutes and reading analogue and digital clocks.

Shape

We will learn about shape, exploring angles, lines and 2D shapes. We will develop our skills in measuring and drawing accurately.
