EAD

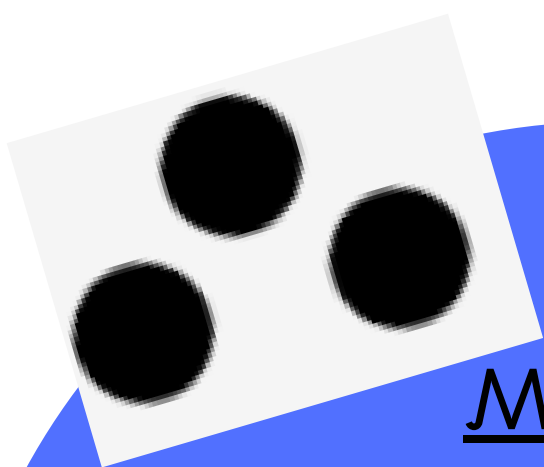
Role play is an important part of our learning at the moment as we make those social connections with each other.
