Our topic for the Summer Term is 'All Change!' Please complete at least 2 of these projects each half term so that by the Summer holidays you will have completed at least 4 of the activities below. These activities are designed to get your creative juices flowing and to be a great opportunity to embed your learning with the support from someone at home. Upload your learning to Tapestry or bring it in, so that we can celebrate it in the classroom. **House points will be awarded!**

Green Fingers

We will be finding out all about plants in Science. Have a go at planting some seeds and see what you can grow!

We'd love to see a picture of you and your plant! Perhaps you could record what happens to your plant in a diary format, using pictures, photos or sentences? Use your measuring skills to track its growth too!

Summer Safari

Go for a Summer stroll and see what living things you can find.

Look out for common wild and garden plants (including trees) and insects, such as bees and butterflies. Keep a record of what you spot. You could make a tally chart, a pictogram or a bar chart to practice your data handling skills too!! **Maybe you can spot part of an animal's life cycle, such as tadpoles, caterpillars or birds nesting!**

Time's Up!

Brush up on your telling the time skills.

Can you help your family to tell the time? Have a go at making your own clock and using it to help you to learn to tell the time. Or maybe you might like to draw a timetable of a typical day at your house with times for the things that you usually do, like getting up or going to bed.

Super Structures!

In DT we are going to be finding out all about structures. Can you find out about a brilliant building or super structure? When and how was it built? Draw a picture or make a presentation about it.

Maybe you might want to create or design your own super structure? You could use junk, construction toys, or even just paper and card. It could be a den in the woods, a home for insects or a home for a toy... you decide!

Remarkable Rescues!

In History we are going to be learning about The Great Fire of London, but can you find out about any other real life remarkable rescues?

Perhaps you want to learn about the daring deeds of Grace Darling or the heroic life of Florence Nightingale? Maybe it is the terrible tale of the Titanic? Become a History detective and carry out your own research, then report back to us to let us know what you've uncovered!

Oh, we do like to be beside the seaside!

We will be learning about what our local seascides were like in the past. Perhaps you could take a trip to a local seaside yourself and let us know what you find there. You could record your observations with a camera or make drawings. You might pop into the local museum too. Or go on a virtual visit to find out about what they were like in the past
