Role play is an important part of our learning at the moment as we make those social connections with each other.

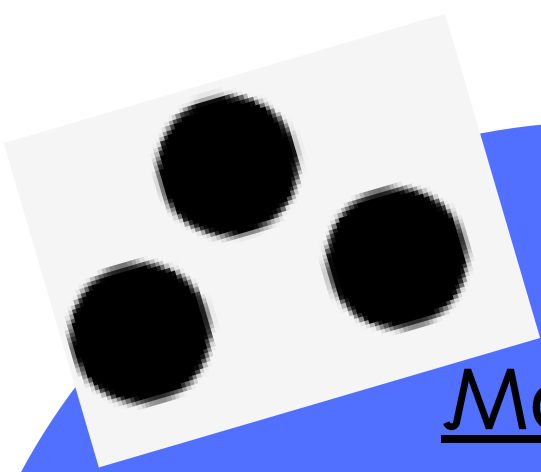
We will be making our own owl paintings.

Maths

This week, we will build on our subitising skills. The children will continue to use 'perceptual' subitising – instant recognition – by saying the number of sounds that they can hear, such as claps or drum beats, without needing to count. They will be encouraged to look closely at small quantities and observe whether the quantity has changed or only the arrangement.



Literacy

We continue to play Fred games every day. We are now recapping the letter sounds that we have learnt and will now have a bigger focus on using these sounds to Fred talk and read words.

This week we are going to continue to write the sounds. Those who are ready will begin to blend sounds to read words.
