Information for the start of school September 2021

Please find information regarding the starting of school on Monday 6th September 2021. If any of this information changes over the summer holidays you will be informed.

For our arrangements regarding Covid please see the letter that will be sent out on Monday 19th July. It will also be found on our website.

Drop off and Pick up

All gates to open at 8:35 and close at 8:45

Years: Reception, Yr1 & 2, Yr5 & 6

Arrangements for these year groups is to stay the same as it has been through Covid. This system has worked well and will be reviewed regularly.

Years 3 & 4

To ease congestion in the alleyway we have decided to ask the children in Years 3 & 4 to enter and exit the school via the Year 6 green gate. The children can then walk down the corridor to their classroom. There will be a member of staff on this gate at all times to take messages or help children if needed. Please do not leave your children unattended in the carpark before the school is open.

Clubs

The list of after school clubs available for September is being sent home today with the Up to the Minute. Our After School Club, Woodpeckers, will continue to run for breakfast (7:30 to 8:30) and after school (3:15-5:30). Places are limited so please ensure that you book in advance.

Uniform

Please ensure that you child has the correct uniform and PE kit in September. Trainers are only allowed for PE, not as part of school uniform, unless there is a specific reason that has been communicated to the school.

Fruit & drink

After morning break all the children have an opportunity to have a snack and a drink. Reception, Years 1 & 2 - fruit/veg is provided.

Years 3-6 - please send your children in with a piece of fruit or vegetable (apple, carrot, banana etc.).

Please do not send in any other types of snacks.

All children need a water bottle (with a non-spill lid or sports lid), filled with water only.

Book bags and ruck sacks

We ask that book bags are used for all children from Reception to Year 4 – no rucksacks please. Please limit the keyrings attached to the sides of the book bags to one! Unfortunately there is not enough room in the classrooms for rucksacks for the younger children. Children in Years 5 & 6 can use rucksacks as they are beginning to take more homework and equipment into school.

Stationery

Infant children (Reception, Years 1 &2) do not need to bring in any stationery.

Junior children (Years 3-6) can bring in their own pencil cases and stationery. These pencil cases cannot be over large or too distracting (they will be sent home if this is the case).
