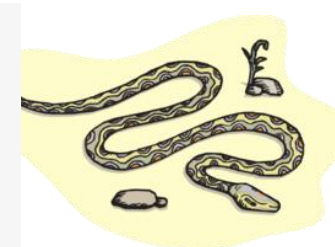




## Spring Term Home Learning Projects "A Walk on the Wild Side!"

These activities are designed to get your creative juices flowing and to be a great opportunity to develop your learning with support from someone at home. <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Marvellous Maps!</u></b></p> <p>Learn the names of the five oceans and the seven continents of the world. Impress us with your knowledge of where they are in the world!</p> <p>You could plan a journey across the globe, visiting each of the continents along the way or make a poster about one of them.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Winter Walk</u></b></p> <p>Wrap up warm and go on a walk with your family. Look out for signs that we are in the season 'Winter'.</p> <p>You could take pictures or draw diagrams to show us what you have discovered.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Fabulous Fruit</u></b></p> <p>In DT we will be tasting fruit and designing our own fruit salad linked to one of our key texts "Handa's Surprise".</p> <p>Why not try a new exotic fruit or even make your own fruit salad. Take a photo and let us know how you got on.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Animal Facts</u></b></p> <p>Find out about an animal that lives in a hot or cold climate using a book, the internet (with a grown up) or perhaps by visiting a zoo.</p> <p>Why not make a <b>fact page</b> about this animal or present the information in a way that you choose?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Counting on and back to 20.</b></p> <p>Collect 20 items e.g. pebbles, building bricks, marbles. Practise counting to 20 in 1s, 2s, and 5s.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Adding within 20.</b></p> <p>How many ways can you make 20? You could use objects to show us how to make 20 and write a number sentence E.g. <math>10+3+7 = 20</math>.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Super Sculpture</u></b></p> <p>Using any material you like make a sculpture of an animal. If your creation is too large to bring in we'd love to see a photo on Tapestry!</p>
