Week 6-9th October This week In Oak class:

Maths

We are looking at simple patterns.

We will be looking at patterns and seeing if we can continue them using blocks, beads and other resources.

We will go outside and create patterns out of natural resources too.

We will also be using our bodies to create patterns-clapping, stomping, jumping,

Communication and Language

This week we are going to begin to look at the date and learn the days of the week.

We are working hard at sitting on the carpet during our phonics session-this is a very short session at the moment while the children get used to sitting.

Personal, Social and Emotional development

We are going to look at the Colour Monster story again this week and exploring another feeling - anger. We are talking about how it is ok to feel this emotion and what we can do to help ourselves and each other when we are feeling like this? We will introduce the calm area in our classroom as a place to go if we are feeling angry and need some space on our own.

Expressive Arts and Design

Our role play area continues to be a birthday party theme but this week we will talk about the other celebrations that we celebrate.

We are reading stories that the children are familiar with so that they can join in with reading it.

We now have a listening station with a CD player playing songs for the children to sing along and dance to.

Phonics

Now we know the names of the pictures for each sound, we are learning the next five letter sounds c.k.u.b.f
