Communication and Language

We are focusing on being Ready, Respectful and Safe as a whole school approach. In Oak class, we are focusing on what 'Ready' looks like on the carpet during whole class learning times- crossed legs, still hands, quiet mouths, listening ears and magnet eyes on the adult.

PSED

Turn taking- this week we are looking at and talking about one of our respectful behaviours- waiting our turn and sharing the resources. We will read stories and discuss what this means and how we can wait our turn,.



UW

This week, we are going to continue to think about what is different about our families but also about individual people. We will talk about different hair, eye and skin colour as well as how we are all good at and enjoy different things. We will share what our favourite things to do are. The children will all paint a self portrait this week to create our Oak class art gallery.

Physical development

At this point in Reception we are working hard to strengthen our gross motor and so are doing lots of physical learning outside, the bikes and trikes are a popular choice. The water and mud kitchen allow us to scoop and lift and carry.

EAD

Role play is an important part of our learning at the moment as we make those social connections with each other. We will be making our own Autumn tree paintings and animals.



Maths

This week, we will explore how numbers can be composed of 1s and, from this, begin to investigate the composition of 3 and 4. will learn from practical experience that a 'whole' is made up of smaller parts and is, therefore, bigger than its parts.

Literacy

We continue to play Fred games every day and are learn a new sound four times a week. This week we are going to start writing the sounds. Those who are ready will begin to blend sounds to read words.
