Counting in 2s, 3s, 5s & 10s

Practise counting in 2s, 5's, 10s or even 3s at home, on the way to school, in the car, at the supermarket, wherever you like!

Why not demonstrate your skills by recording yourself, taking a photo or writing out your step counting.



In Geography we will be learning about map making. Can you create your own map? It could be a map of where you live, your house, your bedroom or a favourite place to go such as the local park.

On your bike!

We are reading Mrs Armitage on Wheels. Take your family on a bike/ scooter ride and show us a picture of you in your safety gear! You might like to design a poster to remind people about bike/ scooter safety.



On the Move!

We are finding out about the history of transport. Research the history of one type of transport. Use your historian skills to ask an older family member about how transport has changed in their lifetime. We are investigating materials in science. Make a collage using materials that you find. You could label the materials that you use or try to make a collage using only one type eg just shiny materials.
