Covid update

As you are aware, we have had a number of Covid-19 cases in the school this week. We are working closely with Public Health England and West Sussex County Council to ensure that our Contingency Plan and Risk Assessment processes are following Government Guidance.

Guidance has changed regularly and it can be confusing. Please read the letter from PHE carefully to ensure you understand what to do.

One area that has caused confusion is when to isolate. Children and adults that have been double jabbed do not need to isolate (even if waiting for a PCR result due to being a close contact). Self isolation is only expected if someone has symptoms or they have tested positive with a PCR test.
