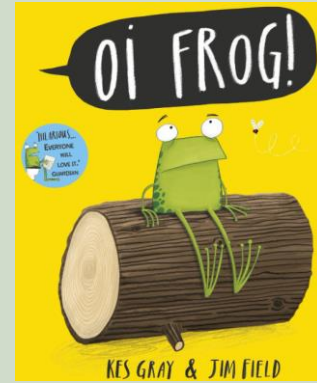
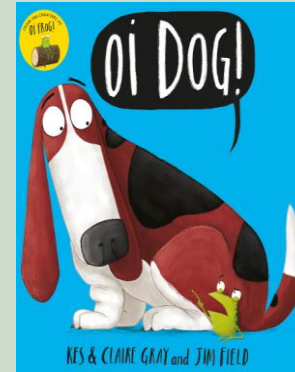
Hobbies:

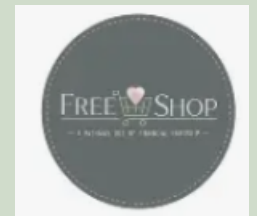
Aims for the summer:

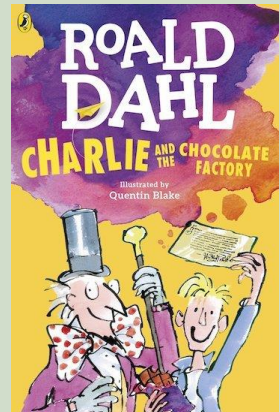
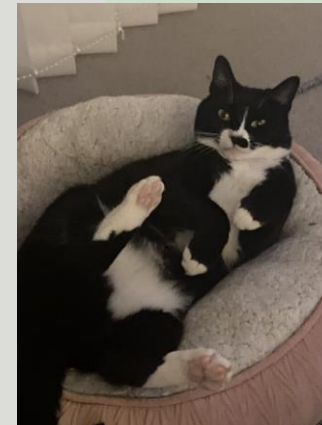


Miss Gregory

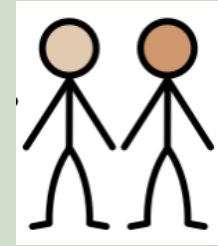
Fun Learning
